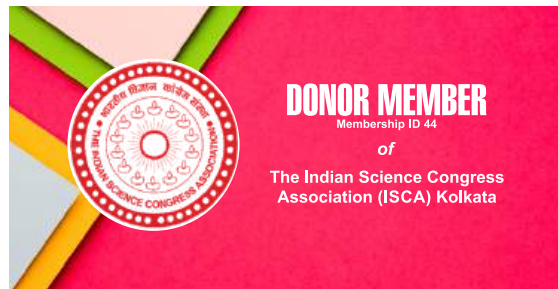
Vikrant University achieved NDLI Club Membership

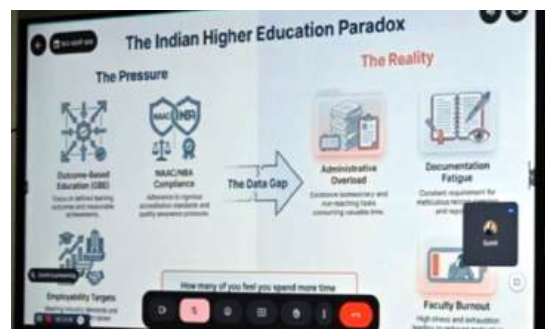

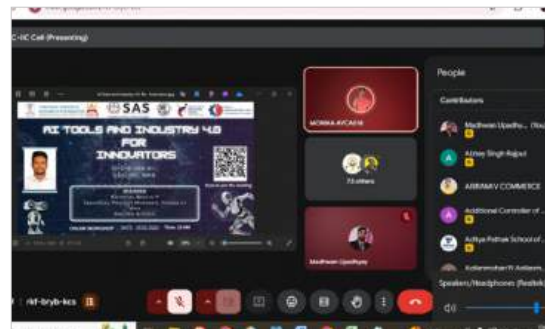

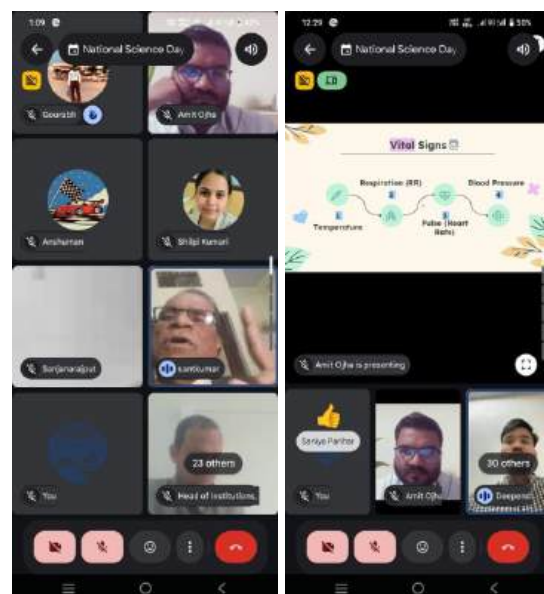
