



Important Notice for prospective students applying for Allied & Healthcare Programs

This notice is issued to all prospective students applying for the Allied & Healthcare programs offered by the University. By taking admission into these programs, students confirm that they have read, understood and accepted the below information and have not relied on any assurance of statutory or professional recognition/ registration.

Role of University

Upon admission, the legal and academic relationship is formed between the student and the University only. The University alone is responsible for all academic and/ or regulatory processes, in accordance with applicable UGC regulations, the University's statutes, ordinances, academic policies and any other applicable law for awarding degrees and approved qualifications.

For abundant clarity, while the University collaborates with Industry partners to assist and facilitate various processes, any such Industry Partner is not equivalent to the University nor its agent, and does not perform any academic and/ or regulatory processes as mentioned above.

Recognition under NCAHP Act

As on the date of admission, neither the University nor the Allied & Healthcare qualifications ("Qualifications") offered by it are recognised under the National Commission for Allied & Healthcare Professions Act, 2021 ("NCAHP" Act, 2021). The University intends to apply and seek recognition from the relevant authorities for its Qualifications. However, it does not promise that such recognition will be obtained in future, or that any such future recognition will apply retrospectively.

Completion of the program shall not automatically grant registration/ licence with NCAHP, any State Allied & Healthcare Council, or any other authority. Any recognition/ registration decision is taken solely by the competent authority in accordance with applicable regulation and laws. Neither the University nor its Industry Partner make any assurance that admission in or completion of the program confers any statutory registration/ licensure or a right to practise under the above laws and regulatory frameworks and have no liability for the same.

Right to modify Academic Processes

The University reserves the sole right and responsibility for any changes in the curriculum, training, examination, delivery mode, duration of the Program etc., whether due to any changes in accordance with applicable law/ notifications by regulatory authorities or otherwise.
